## The Introduction

- ❖ The BIG Idea: For God's glory, you should vote responsibly.
  - > God's Glory ~ What does the **Bible** say about God and government? → The **Why?**
  - ➤ Responsibly ~ What laws does the U.S. Constitution allow at Federal, State, and Local levels? → The What?
  - ➤ Vote ~ How should Christians vote on the particular issues, responsibly considering what the Bible and Constitution dictate? → The How?

## The Issues and Your Vote

- Overall Principles and Considerations
  - > Salt and Light
  - ➤ Biblical Axiom: "Who we *are* (Christians and Americans) should determine *what* we do—belief determines behavior... including how we vote!" → *Principles* (Biblical and Constitutional) *vs Pragmatics* (unintended consequences spiral...)
  - > \*\* Our Priorities for the Issues:
    - 1) Biblical: Morally Commanded? God honoring? Permissible? Practical? (MSA!—Moral)
    - 2) Constitutional: Allowed? What level of Government? ("Legal")?
      - NB: Unlimited King and Limited Government (Federalism and Separation of Powers)

  - > Capital Punishment/Crime
  - > War
  - Marriage
  - > Healthcare
- The Issues: Liberty
  - > Education
  - > Freedom of Religion
