### **I. GODLY SORROW** (II Cor 7:10; cf. Ps 51:1-17)

- A. Conviction
  - 1. Conscience-stricken, inner awareness
    - a. Paul on Damascus Road
    - b. Augustine re pears stolen

  - 2. Knowledge clear, misdeeds demonstrable
    - a. David after Nathan's rebuke

    - 3. More than feeling bad when apprehended
- B. Contrition
  - 1. Sincere remorse, broken-hearted

- D. Conversion/Repentence (metanoia) essential: turning around—Mt 4:17; Mt 3:8; Acts 3:18-19
  - 1. Right Turn, pivotal decision, evident in Scripture

  - 2. Right Turns in history
