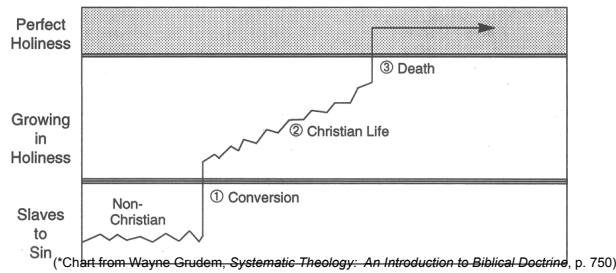


Growing in Christ-likeness (Sanctification)



❖ Introduction



1) Conversion

a) *Justification*: “Declared Righteous” ~ Standing → Saved from the **penalty** of sin.

2) Christian Life

a) *Sanctification*: “Growth in Christ-likeness” ~ Maturity → Saved from the **power** of sin.

3) Death

a) *Glorification*: “Final Redemption” ~ Resurrection Bodies → Saved from the **presence** of sin.

| Justification | Sanctification |
|----------------------------|--------------------------------|
| Legal Standing | Internal Condition |
| Once for all Time | Continuous throughout Life |
| Entirely God's Work | We Cooperate |
| Perfect in this Life | Not Perfect in this Life |
| The Same in All Christians | Greater in Some than in Others |

❖ Holiness

- **Definition** (ἁγιότης): God's separateness, transcendence, uniqueness, and moral purity ~ *Wholly Other*.
- **Text**: Isaiah 6:1-5
- **Implications**: Genesis 17:1

❖ Sanctification

- **Definition** (ἁγιασμός): “Making holy” in the moral sense. Cannot be separated from *justification*.
- **Relationship**: Set Apart → Grow in Christian Maturity ~ “Christ-likeness.”

 - Hebrews 13:12
