The BIG Idea: For God's glory, you should vote responsibly.

The Bible and God's Glory

- Jesus and Pilate
 - > Text: **John 18:33-38a, 19:9-11

Human Government

- > Origin
 - God is a God of law and order (Consistent with His character) ~ Punishment for Disobedience (back to the Garden)
 - God is the source of all human government
- Function
 - Text: **Romans 13:1-7 (Thesis and Premise—vv. 1-2 ~ starts with Origin of Government)
 - Protection (v. 3)
 - Punishment (v. 4)
 - Promotion (v. 4)
 - Promote General Welfare ~ "minister to you for good" (NB: NOT the good of the rulers!)
 - Promote Human Liberty ~ Freedom from "Bondage"
- ➤ General ("Ideal") Principle: The institution of government is good. *Lawless* anarchy is not only rebellion against human authority, but actual rebellion against God! **Romans 13:5-7

Human (Our) Purpose

- ➤ Biblical Principle: Humans are the pinnacle of creation → "imago dei"
- Ultimate Purpose: Glorify God (salvation)! ~ "Everyone who is called by My name, Whom I have created for My glory; I have formed him, yes, I have made him."
 I have made him."
- > Mandate (under Ultimate Purpose): Have Dominion
- ** Our Responsibility to Government (~ macro view—cf. Romans 13:1-2)
 - Text: 1 Peter 2:13-17
 - We should recognize and accept that the powers that be are ordained by God.
 - We should pay our taxes.
 - We should pray for the leaders in government.
